

King County HMIS Inventory: Referral Pathway Definitions

This document is to assist in defining the various Referral Pathway Housing drop down options and act as a guide to housing providers for when to use each one. Please update a unit's referral pathways to be as accurate as possible based on funding streams and what referral the unit requires. This detail will support accuracy across the system and streamline funder monitoring.

Option	Guidance
Right of Way Set Aside – CE	The program is funded with Right of Way dollars and the unit is set aside for Right of Way connected clients.
Seattle Foundation Phase 4 – CE	The program receives Trueblood funding. This drop down is selected on units that require a Trueblood class member to meet minimum funding requirements.
Sage MH Program Set Aside – CE	The program is funded with the expectation of a portion of SAGE set aside. These units are not filled by the CE system.
PACT Set Aside	The program is funded with the expectation of a portion of PACT set aside. These units are not filled by the CE system.
Other MH Set Aside	The program is funded with the expectation of a portion of other Mental Health set aside. These units are not filled by the CE system.
Local HTH – CE	The program is 100% CoC funded and braided with HTH funding. The unit is to be filled by CE System with a local referral.
Regional HTH – CE	The program is NOT 100% CoC funded and has HTH funding. The unit is to be filled by the CE System (non-local fill) and has HTH eligibility requirements.
DV Coordinated Housing Access Point	This is a funded DV program and the resources are to be filled by referral from the DV Coordinated Housing Access Point.
King County System Connected	Programs that have received specific King County System Connected funding. The unit is to be filled by the CE System with appropriate System Connected referral.
Coordinated Entry System	Programs that have the funding requirement to participate in Coordinated Entry. General option to indicate unit needs to be filled by the CE system.
Local Set Aside	Programs have a funding requirement that requires a local referral (non HTH funding). The CE system will identify a local referral for this unit.

HTH – not filled by CE	The program is NOT 100% CoC funded and has HTH funding. The unit does not participate in Coordinated Entry System.
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
